

Installation Instructions for Compost Tea Kit (Spigot)

Materials Included in Kit

- Spigot
- Two Screws
- Caulk

Tools Required

- Drill
 - Phillips Drill Bit
 - 3/4" Drill Bit
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Easy Install

Along the edge of the bottom of your composter you will need to locate the spot which you wish to install the spigot, we recommend you install it backwards so when tilted the spigot points straight down so you can easily run water through the compost and dispense water directly into the pail. (Look on the back of this page for a picture of what we recommended how the spigot should be placed.)

Use 3/4" Drill Bit to drill a hole at desired location.

Apply caulk to the base of the spigot. This forms the watertight seal so make sure you apply generously and remember you can always remove excess later.

Pop the Spigot into the hole. (If you are having trouble, use a smooth blade like a box cutter to slightly bevel the edges of the hole to help the spigot pop into place.)

Using the Phillips Drill Bit, drill the spigot in place (lightly), one screw each on the sides of the spigots in the grooves.



This is what it should look like when you are done.
